1) Organisational Structure

Live Music Now operates throughout the UK, with English branches covering London/South East, South West, and across the North, and national branches covering Northern Ireland and Wales with a sister organisation in Scotland. This post is based in Live Music Now South East branch and will work closely with the Branch Director, as well as the UK Comms Team.

A team of Strategic Directors leads the development of LMN's work in the areas of Adult Social Care, Healthcare, Children and Young People and Musicians' Development, delivered through the branch network across the UK. Each branch is run by a Director who reports to the Executive Director. The Exec Director reports to the Chief Executive, who in turn reports to the Chairman and Board of Trustees.

2) Main duties & responsibilities

We are seeking a highly motivated and organised Freelance Project Manager to support Live Music Now's South East Branch to deliver 6 inclusive community music events (*All Together Now* concerts) for families of children and young people with additional learning needs and disabilities around Medway.

The role will involve scheduling concerts, maintaining relationships across all partners, event management, budget management, evaluation and community consultation.

Deliverables:

- Delivery and attendance at 6 *All Together Now* events for families of children and young people with additional learning needs and disabilities around Medway
- Development and management of 10+ new referral partnerships with organisations in Medway into the work and activities of Live Music Now in Medway
- Gathering evaluation data and feedback at all events, and compiling that into an end of project report as well as brief monthly updates for the project funder
- Attendance at regular meetings with project partners and host venues, as well as Live Music Now South East Branch staff

Responsibilities:

- To lead on partnership liaison and all aspects of project organisation
- To coordinate concert dates and venues between all partners and musicians
- To recruit event participants/audiences



- To deliver project marketing and support communications and PR, working with the Live Music Now Comms Team
- To deliver community consultation with potential referral partners of All Together Now and other Live Music Now projects in Medway.
- To manage the project budget and contracts
- To provide on the ground support at all events and collect evaluation data at all events
- To liaise between the project mentors and musicians providing support where needed
- To provide administrative support for any required project materials
- To provide regular updates to the project funder and attend regular meetings with the project funder as necessary
- To ensure safe working practices are followed as per our H&S policies, risk assessments and Covid safety guidelines
- To be responsible to the Live Music Now South East Director and report on progress on a regular basis

3) Terms & Conditions

The post is contracted on a temporary freelance basis to start as soon as possible with project delivery to be complete by the end of March or April 2024. The fee will be £4,000 inclusive of expenses and will be paid upon receipt of invoices. It is expected to be between 20-25 days of work depending on experience and speed.
