- a link to a public or 'unlisted' YouTube/Vimeo video (must not be 'private')
- a link to a cloud-based service like Dropbox/Google Drive/iCloud, that can be viewed in a web browser. Files must not require downloading.

We are unable to accept videos that require downloading, links to playlists, channels or collections of videos, or videos hosted on Facebook, Instagram, Twitter/X or TikTok.
